Live Aboards

If you're more comfortable under the water than over it, we highly recommend booking a dive boat trip. Many of the most popular ones are 3-5 days long, with some that are longer. Live aboard a dive boat and see different reefs every single day, with seahorses, tropical fish, squid, and more easily on view.

Visit Nassau

A short boat trip away from the Abacos is Nassau, the capital of the Bahamas and full of fun for everyone. Visit a famous rum distillery, have conch fritters on a popular beach, or even visit our sister property [A Stones Throw Away](#), which is perched on one of the highest points of the entire island.

Explore Lucayan

A 40-acre spread of mangrove, palm and pine trees, Lucayan National Park also contains the impressive Gold Rock Beach (which appears in two of the "Pirates of the Caribbean" movies), as well as the Burial Mound Cave (where the remains of indigenous Lucayans were discovered in 1986) and Ben's Cave.

See the Pink Sands

Another exceptional experience you can enjoy in the Bahamas is sinking your toes into a beach with [pink sand](#). This Harbour Island beach with its rose-hued shoreline makes for a truly dreamy seaside landscape. It makes for a fantastic exploration. Renter a charter boat to get there for even more water fun.

Visit Dean's Blue Hole

A water-filled natural limestone cavern, Dean's Blue Hole plunges 663 feet below ground level on Long Island, part of a string of Bahamian islands south of Nassau and New Providence Island. This shallow lagoon is truly breathtaking; with a deep blue center and crowned by white sand.

Beach Camping

If you're a rugged and intrepid adventurer, we recommend beach camping! Several sea kayaking companies and boat charters offer overnight packages for either staying the night on their sailboat or even on the beach; where the warm and balmy winds will keep you cozy all night long.
